Mary and Martha and New Year's Resolutions

Brothers and Sisters!

In the Gospel of Luke, we hear about Mary and Martha (10:38-42), a story which provides an important lesson about our Christian walk with God and is something we could apply to our New Year's resolutions.

It is a lesson about hearing the word of the Lord and being teachable.

You may remember how it goes. One day, Jesus was visiting the home of Mary, Martha, and Lazarus. They were friends of His, and supporters of His ministry and the apostles. They lived in Bethany, a village just over the Mount of Olives, about two miles from Jerusalem. Jesus liked to stop there on occasion to relax and be with friends before He entered the big city.

While He was there, He began to teach, as was natural for Him to do, after all, they called Him the "Teacher" (Luke 10:25). As Jesus was teaching, Mary sat at the Lord's feet, listening to Him. She was inspired by what He said and was learning a great deal. However, her sister Martha was "distracted with much serving" (Luke 10:40). What could Martha be doing that was more important than listening to Jesus? Perhaps she was tending to her guests or preparing them a meal. Certainly, one can understand she had guests in her house and that she wanted to show hospitality and kindness to them. Yet, in all her busyness and determination she was missing out on the main event: Jesus's teaching. She was so distraught that she even interrupted the Teacher and asked Him: "Lord, do You not care that my sister has left me to serve alone? Tell her then to help me" (Luke 10:40). Martha thought she had good reason to miss out on Jesus's sermon, but instead, the Lord answered her, "Martha, Martha, you are anxious and troubled about many things, but one thing is necessary. Mary has chosen the good portion, which will not be taken away from her" (Luke 10:41-42).

We don't hear the end of this story. My hope would be that Martha realized her fault and stopped what she was doing and joined in listening to Jesus teach. Mary was teachable, and Jesus said she had chosen "the good portion." The good portion was the words that fell from His lips, the gospel of our salvation.

To be teachable is a godly virtue, and something we could all work on, even me. I hope this year we find ourselves more like Mary and less like Martha.

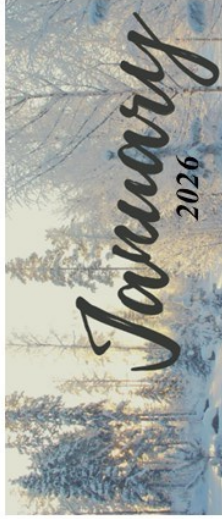


Members from Grace Lutheran filled goody bags December 21st to be handed out at the Christmas Eve Service.
